Changing Direction

Migrants from University to Work



Current status: 2020





In the Project Changing Direction,

refugees and migrants are accompanied after dropping out of education. The goal is a self-determined and sustainable career start in Germany. Through a combination of workshops, e-learning units and individual support, the project offers a comprehensive range of services.

Programme duration and scope

The participation period is six to eight months, depending on the content covered. Two to three months of this period are spent on a full- or part-time internship. The exercises of the digital learning platform can be completed on your own schedule. Workshops take place on weekends, consulting appointments are arranged individually.

Certificate of participation

After a successful completion, participants will receive a certificate of participation and a letter of recommendation from the project staff.



Overview of the project contents

There are 5 methods the project works with:

- The **portfolio** is a folder that contains all relevant documents of the educational biography of the participants and in which the development during participation will be documented.
- **Individual guidance** supports the participants during the entire duration of the project.
- The **workshops** help to deepen the learned content and offer the opportunity for questions and networking amongst the participants.
- The **Internship** gives an insight into the work field. The participants are supported in preparing their application and receive individual support during the internship
- The **digital learning platform** contains learning materials (videos and educational games) on various topics, such as: orientation on the training and job market and exercises of the application process.
